How do you ask someone about their father's job? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What does your father do? 3. What is the meaning of funny & when do we say someone has a sense of humor? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funny means causing laughter or amusement. We say someone has a sense of humor if they can understand and express things in a funny, a musing way. 	3
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Returning a Question: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In a conversation, to return a question, you can mirror the same question back or ask a related follow-up. For example, if someone asks, "How was your weekend?" you could reply and then ask, "And yours?" This keeps the conversation flowing naturally. 2. Present Continuous Tense: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The present continuous tense is used to describe actions that are happening right now or around the current time. For example, "I am eating dinner" or "They are watching a movie." It's formed with the subject + am/is/are + verb ending in -ing. 	4
