Animals like leopards, wolves, and cheetahs need large spaces to run and hunt, which zoos cannot provide. Many zoo animals don't look happy because they cannot behave naturally - wolves cannot hunt, leopards cannot climb trees properly, and elephants cannot travel long distances. Baby animals born in zoos may never learn important skills they would learn in the wild. <b><u>Sadly</u></b>, some zoos keep animals in cages that are too small, which causes pain and stress to the animals. While some zoos help injured animals or endangered species like pandas, most wild animals belong in their natural homes.
